#### **DRE GRAHAM**



Dr. Dakeyan Chá Dré Graham (Dr. Dré) currently advocates for student, educator, and parent empowerment and opportunity as the Director of Educational Equity and Outreach for Alachua County Public Schools. He actively travels the nation delivering keynote speeches, professional development seminars, and workshops in the educational, instructional, musical, and DEIA (Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Access) spaces. He is also widely sought out as a music clinician, having worked with band and orchestra students and ensembles across the southeastern United States. At the start of his educational career, he served as the Director of Instrumental Studies at his alma mater, C. Leon King High School in Tampa, FL, for 11 years. During this tenure, he was blessed to teach within a classroom that personified the very

definition of diversity. Through the lens of his multicultural student body, Dr. Dré gained incredible perspective on the significance of intentional, focused, equitable educational experiences and opportunities for ALL students! It was this emphasis on cultivating an environment of belonging, acceptance, tenacity, perseverance, ownership, and independence that ultimately elevated him to being selected as the 2020 Florida Teacher of the Year and Christa McAuliffe Ambassador for Education. Along with this acknowledgment came a platform for his perspective; one that places the needs of ALL students at the foundation of EVERY educational thought: Not only does every student contain the potential for success, but they ALL deserve an equitable educational experience tailored to their specific needs, desires, and goals in order to pursue the best version of themselves.

Dr. Graham holds Bachelor's and Master's Degrees in Music Education (University of Florida), a Master's in Educational Leadership (Concordia University), a Ph.D. in Music Education (University of South Florida), an Ed.D. in Learning Design and Performance Technology (Florida State University) and a Doctorate of Musical Arts in Instrumental Conducting (University of Florida).

Dr. Graham is blessed to share life with his wife, Casey (also an educator), and daughter, Aaliyah.

#### TOM VIKING



Mr. Viking has been performing and teaching for over 30 years. He is also an active conductor, clinician and adjudicator of concert and marching bands as well as jazz bands and solo & ensemble performers. Mr. Viking is also a marching band drill designer and instructor. He has taught numerous summer music camps and marching band camps including repeat visits to Ferrum College and The Florida State University. After attending VanderCook College of Music in Chicago, Mr. Viking spent several years traveling as a musician and performer. He served as Director of Bands at King High School in Tampa Florida and Seven Springs Middle School in Trinity Florida. During his 18 years at Seven Springs Middle School, the band program grew from 32 students to over 300 and consistently earned the highest rating from the Florida Band Masters. Mr. Viking has earned group and individual awards from the Florida Band Masters Association. He is a two-time 2 Teacher of the Year recipient and has several listings in Who's Who among American Teachers. He is an active member of the Florida School Music Educators Association, the Florida Band

Masters Association, and the Florida Music Supervisors Association. He currently serves as the Supervisor of Fine Arts for Pasco County Schools and has held that position for the last nine years. Mr. Viking received his Bachelor of Arts & Master of Arts degrees from the University of South Florida.

#### TED HOPE



Ted M. Hope has served as the conductor of the Fanfare Winds and Hillsborough Community College for the past 10 years. He was affiliated with the Hillsborough County School District for 39 years and retired as the Supervisor of Middle and Secondary Music after 19 years of service in March of 2023. He received his Bachelor of Music Education from Florida State University, and his Master of Music Education and Education Specialist from the University of Southern Mississippi. He subsequently taught in the public schools for twenty years as band director at Hillsborough High School (1984-1987) and Bloomingdale High School (1987-2004). He is a member of the Florida Bandmasters Association where he served as chairman and secretary. Mr. Hope's professional affiliations include Music Educators National Conference, Hillsborough County Secondary Music Council, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, the Bay Area

Saxophone Quartet and the Hillsborough Association of School Administrators . Mr. Hope is an active clinician and adjudicator in concert band, jazz ensemble, and marching band.

#### **JOHN DAVIS**



Originally from Boyertown, Pennsylvania, John Davis served as a music educator for 31 years. John served as a Teacher Peer Evaluator for the Hillsborough County Public Schools in Tampa, Florida, and as Director of Instrumental Music at Riverview High School from 2007-2023. His Florida bands and orchestras regularly received Superior ratings at FBA and FOA events and have twice been selected to perform at Bands of America Regional and National Concert Band Festivals, while three of his programs were selected as Music Demonstration Schools by the Florida Department of Education. In addition, his Flanagan HS program was named a Grammy Signature School and winner of the 2002 Grammy Award of Special Merit. His marching band at Seminole High School was a Bands of America Regional Medalist, 4-time Regional Finalist, and a Semi-Finalist at the BOA Grand National Championships in addition to being named the 1996 WGI Friendship Cup Class AA National Champion. Under his direction, the Flanagan High School Falcon Sound was a three-time FMBC State Finalist and Class 5A Runner-up.

In 2002, Mr. Davis had the honor of being named Arts Teacher of the Year in Broward County along with a Grammy Award of Special Merit for his work at Flanagan HS. He was also named Riverview HS Teacher of the Year in 2010. He is a past member and brass instructor for the DCI World Champion Cadets Drum and Bugle Corps and DCI-Finalist Glassmen Drum and Bugle Corps. Mr. Davis also co-founded the Tampa Bay Symphonic Winds and Pride Marching Band in 2015 and served a four-year stint as a Board Member and Band Coordinator for the Ybor City Snow on 7thAvenue Parade. His compositions and arrangements have been performed by academic, community, and professional ensembles nationally and internationally, with the world premiere of his "Brazilian Folk Song Suite" in March 2018 as the new Associate Conductor of the Grainger Wind Symphony in Melbourne, Australia.

Mr. Davis holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Music Education from Penn State University, and graduateds*umma cum laud*with a Master of Wind Conducting from James Madison University in 2005.In 2017, he completed his Master of Education Management and Leadership degree with High Distinction at the University of Melbourne in Melbourne, Australia.

#### ANDREA SZAROWICZ



Mrs. Andrea Szarowicz has been the director of the Steinbrenner High School Orchestra since Fall of 2019. Her previous places of employment were; Gaither High School (2008 – 2019), Monroe Middle School from 2004 – 2008, and 10 elementary schools as a floating Strings Specialist before that. Her undergraduate degree is from the University of South Florida (2003), with a Bachelor in Music (violin) and Gerontology; She currently holds a Master's in Business from the University of Arizona (2006) and a Masters in Music Education from Florida State University (2012). She was the first USF "Herd of Thunder Color Guard Captain. During her time teaching color guard, she was the director of color guards at Land O'Lakes High School (00-08'), Director of Color Guards at Gaither High School (05'-12'), Director of Color Guards at Auburndale High School (07'-10') Newsome High School Guard Staff (09'-13'), Strawberry Crest High School 2017. When Mrs. Szarowicz is not at work, she loves hanging out with her husband and nine-year-old son.

#### **BRYAN BRAUE**



Bryan Braue serves as the Director of Bands for the University of Texas Permian Basin where his responsibilities include directing the "Spirit of the Permian Basin" Marching Band, overseeing the Basketball Pep Band, conducting the departments Symphonic Winds and Brass Choir, and teaching courses in conducting and music education. Additional duties within the Department of Music at UTPB include serving as the Academic Advisor for all wind and percussion majors, as well as supervising elementary/secondary student interns in and around the Midland/Odessa area. Dr. Braue earned his Doctorate in Musical Arts with an emphasis in Instrumental Conducting from the University of Florida, where he studied with Dr. David Waybright, Professor Jay Watkins, and Dr. Chip Birkner. While completing his course work, his responsibilities included co-teaching Basic Conducting, serving as a Graduate Conductor for the universities Wind Symphony and Monday Night Concert Band, and assisted with the Gator Marching Band in

multiple facets, including drill writing, music arranging, and co-teaching the Drumline.

A native of Vero Beach, Florida, Dr. Braue earned his Bachelor's degree in Music Education from Stetson University where he studied under Dr. Bobby Adams. In 2006, he became the Director of Bands for Clearwater High School where his teaching responsibilities included the Marching Band, Symphonic Winds, Jazz Band, Percussion Ensemble, Music Theory, and Music History. In addition to his CHS responsibilities, Dr. Braue also served as the Adjunct Professor of Percussion at Clearwater Christian College, was the District Chairman for the Florida Bandmasters Association District IX, and was Chairman for the Pinellas All-County Secondary Bands. From 2011-2013, he would attend the University of South Florida, earning a Master's Degree in Instrumental Conducting. Upon his graduation, Dr. Braue would be appointed as the universities Assistant Director of Bands, a position he would serve in for six years. During his tenure at USF, Dr. Braue worked with the universities "Herd of Thunder" Marching Band, Basketball Pep Band, Show Band, Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band, and Concert Bands. Additionally, he served as the Executive Director for the schools Summer Music Camps program, Festival of Winds, and Symphonic Celebration.

#### TRAVIS HENRY



Travis A. Henry is the director of music (band and orchestra) at River Ridge Middle School, where he has also served as Fine Arts/Foreign Language department head and on the School Advisory Committee. In his tenure at the school, the band and orchestra has consistently received the higher ratings at the Florida Bandmasters Association [FBA] and Florida Orchestra Association [FOA] District Concert Music Performance Assessment. During his tenure, many of his students have participated as members of the Pasco All-County Band, Pasco All-County Jazz Band, Pasco All-County Chorus, FBA Middle School Honors Band and FBA All-State Middle School Band.

Mr. Henry has served as a clinician/conductor for numerous All-County and Honor Bands, and for summer camp bands at the University of Tampa and The Florida State University. He currently serves as an FBA

adjudicator for solo/ensemble events, concert music and sight reading. He has served on the executive boards of the FBA and the Florida Music Education Association [FMEA]. He has also worked with the Polk County School Board as a writer and reviewer for the Race To The Top Fine Arts Assessment Team. He also assists the Pasco County Schools Fine Arts Program Coordinator in organizing the Pasco All-County High School and Middle School Bands.

Mr. Henry received the Bachelor of Music Education from The Florida State University. He has memberships in the FBA, FMEA, NAfME, ASBDA, and Phi Beta Mu International Bandmasters Fraternity. He is an active member of Hillsdale Baptist Church, where he has served as deacon, Sunday School teacher, and choir director. 
